liver is so damaged that it cannot function very well. If possible see a nutritionist (diet specialist) for advice on what to eat to stay healthy. **A diet based on MyPlate is generally recommended.** www.choosemyplate.gov

Healthy Eating Habits:

- Do eat lots of fruits and vegetables as well as chicken, fish and some lean red meat. It is also good to eat cereals, bread, rice and pasta as long as they are labeled as multigrain.
- Do not eat any raw or undercooked shellfish because they could damage your liver even further.
- Try to stay away from foods that are high in fat, sugar, and salt. If possible stay away from fried or over-processed food that you can get from fast food restaurants.
- Avoid alcohol because it can further damage the liver.
